The other is We Care Together, a zine filled with tips and wisdom from LGBTIQA+ young people about self care and collective care in an often challenging world.

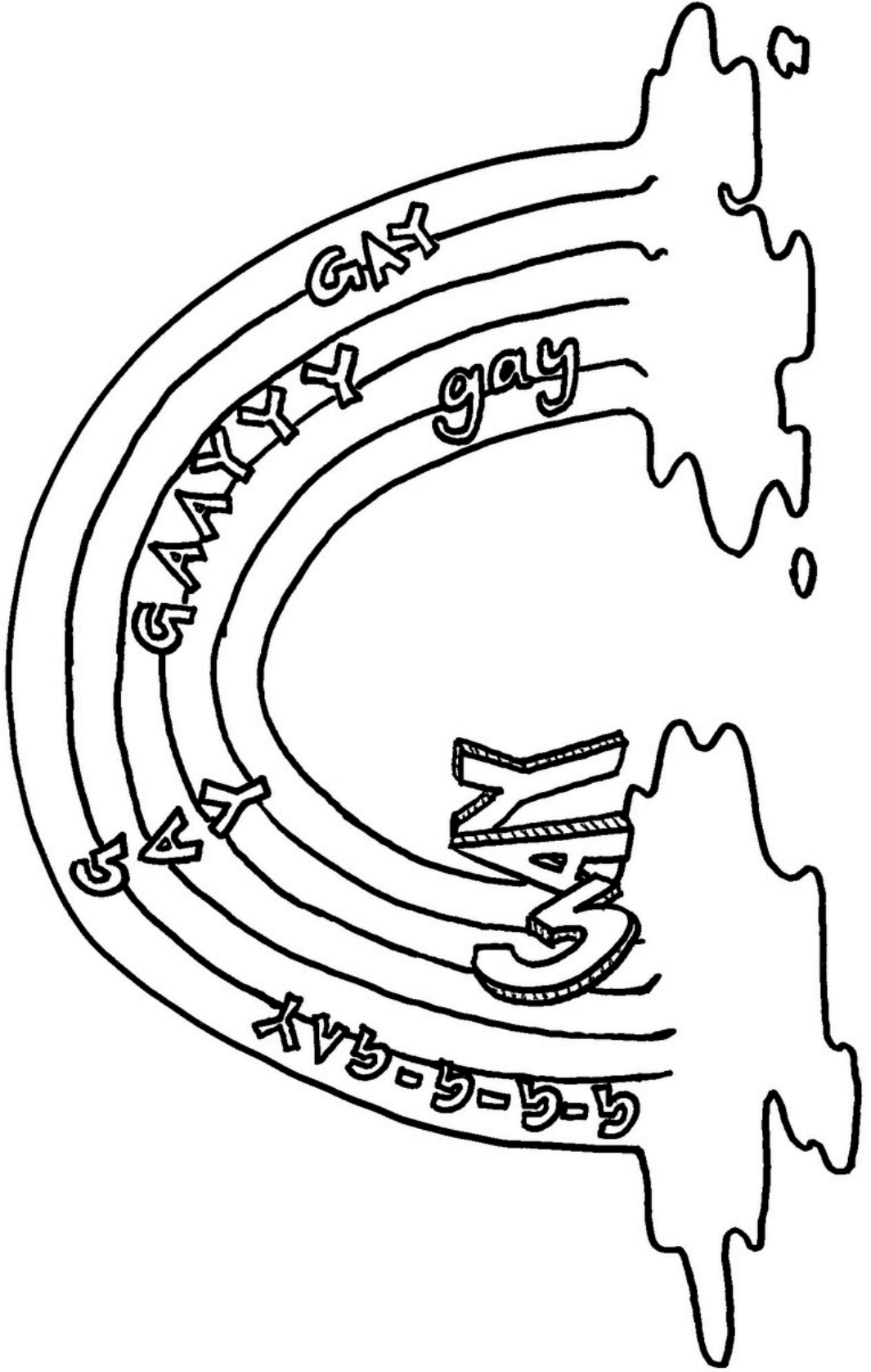
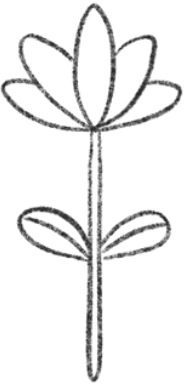
